PRIZE DRAW TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Prize Draw Overview

England and Wales Cricket Board Limited, a company incorporated and registered in England and Wales with company number 03251364, and having its registered office at Lord's Ground, St. John's Wood, London, NW8 8QZ (the "**ECB**"), is organising and operating three optional prize draws for a chance to win certain prizes (described in paragraph 9 below) following the completion of the cricket playing survey 2025 (the "**Survey**") (each a "**Prize Draw**").

1. Prize Draw entrants ("**Entrant(s)**") are deemed to have accepted, and agreed to be bound by, these terms and conditions (the "**Prize Draw Terms and Conditions**") upon entry into any Prize Draw(s). A copy of these Prize Draw Terms and Conditions will be posted on the ECB's website at www.ecb.co.uk (the "**Website**").
2. The decision of the ECB regarding any aspect of a Prize Draw is final and binding (including as to the award of the Prizes) and no correspondence will be entered into regarding any such decision.

Entry Process

The Survey and each Prize Draw will be open for entry between 09:00am BST on Monday 21st July 2025 and 11.59pm BST on Sunday 24th August 2025 (the "**Entry Period**"). Any entries received outside of the Entry Period and/or other than in accordance with the entry requirements set out in these Prize Draw Terms and Conditions will not be considered.

Each Prize Draw is open to all individuals aged 14 years and over within the United Kingdom who successfully complete the Survey and tick the box to confirm that they wish to be entered into one or more of the Prize Draws. Entrants must select the individual box for each Prize Draw (up to a maximum of all 3 Prize Draws) they wish to enter. Any Entrants under the age of 18 must obtain the written consent of their parent and/or carer to enter any Prize Draw and to claim any Prize (as defined below). Employees of the ECB are not eligible to enter any of the Prize Draws.

To enter a Prize Draw, individuals must access the Survey via their email, Facebook, Instagram, X and/or through the Website and complete the Survey online. Entrants must enter their contact details at the end of the Survey and select which Prize Draw(s) they wish to enter. Entries will not be accepted by any other means.

3. Each Prize Draw is free to enter, and no purchase is necessary. Only one (1) entry to each Prize Draw per Entrant is permitted.
4. In entering a Prize Draw, each Entrant confirms that they are eligible to do so and eligible to claim the Prize that they may win. The ECB may require an Entrant to provide proof that they are eligible to enter the Prize Draw(s) (including proof of age and/or proof of their parent's or carer's consent).

Prize

5. Each of the three Prize Draws has its own prize(s) and Entrants have the chance to win:
 - One England Men's Test Team signed shirt (Prize Draw 1 – one winner)
 - One England Women's IT20 Team signed shirt (Prize Draw 2 – one winner)
 - One England Men's Test Team signed bat (Prize Draw 3 – one winner)

each a “Prize”, together the “Prizes”.

6. The ECB will select each winning Entrant at random via a computer-generated selection process on or soon after Sunday 24th August 2025 (the “**Draw Date**”). Each winning Entrant will be notified (as soon as reasonably practicable after the Draw Date) using the contact details provided on entry into the relevant Prize Draw(s).
7. Each winning Entrant must confirm that they are able to accept the relevant Prize within the time specified in the ECB’s Prize notification. In the event that any winning Entrant fails to confirm their acceptance of the relevant Prize by this date or is unable to accept the Prize that they have won for any reason, or the ECB determines that the relevant winner has breached these Prize Draw Terms and Conditions, the ECB reserves the right to offer the relevant Prize to another Entrant selected at random. The ECB does not accept any responsibility for failure by any winner(s) to claim their Prize.

ECB will endeavour to deliver the relevant Prize to a winning Entrant within 2 months from the date of acceptance of such Prize but shall not be responsible for any delay in delivery. Each Prize is non-exchangeable and non-transferable, and no cash alternative is offered. A Prize does not include anything not expressly set out in these Prize Draw Terms and Conditions, including but not limited to, associated travel and accommodation or other general expenses.

8. The ECB reserves the right to substitute each/any winner’s Prize for an alternative prize of equal or greater value if necessary (in the ECB’s sole discretion).

Limitation of Liability

9. None of ECB, nor any of their affiliates, agents, employees, officers, directors or representatives will be liable (to the extent permitted by law) for any direct, indirect or consequential loss or damage arising out of the organising or holding of the Prize Draws or as a result of any Entrant’s participation in any Prize Draw or as a result of the winning, collecting, use or enjoyment of any Prize, or if any of the Prize Draws do not run as planned or if any part of any prize is unable to be delivered for any reason. Prize Draw Entrants’ statutory rights are not affected.
10. If any Prize Draw or any part of it is not capable of running or being completed as planned for any reason, including but not limited to reasons of infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, technical failures or any other causes beyond the control of the ECB, the ECB reserves the right to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the relevant Prize Draw without liability.
11. The ECB accepts no responsibility or liability for any Prize Draw entries that are outside of the Entry Period, delayed or otherwise not successfully completed, regardless of cause, including (without limitation) due to a technical fault, technical malfunction, computer hardware or software failure, satellite, network or server failure, of any kind.

Entrants’ Personal Data

12. Any personal data relating to any individual which is received by the ECB in relation to the Prize Draw will be used in accordance with applicable UK data protection legislation, the ECB's Privacy Notice which can be found at: [Privacy Notice Recreational Game Cricket Survey 2025](#) and the ECB's privacy policy which can be found at: <https://www.ecb.co.uk/privacy>.
13. The ECB may be required to either publish or make available information that indicates that a valid award took place. To comply with this obligation the ECB will send the surname and county of Winners to anyone who or sends a letter addressed to the Recreational Game team of the ECB using the address given above, (enclosing a self-addressed envelope) within one month after conclusion of the Entry Period. If an Entrant objects to any or all of his/her surname and county being published or made available, please contact the ECB using the email address or postal address referred to in this clause. In such circumstances, the ECB must still provide the information to the Advertising Standards Authority on request.
14. Any request to exercise any legal rights under data protection law or in relation to the ECB's privacy policy should be addressed to privacy@ecb.co.uk.

General

15. ECB reserves the right to refuse entry to any of the Prize Draws, to disqualify from any Prize Draw, or to refuse to award the Prize(s) to anyone who it reasonably considers has breached these Prize Draw Terms and Conditions or to anyone, who in the ECB's sole opinion, has otherwise acted improperly or dishonestly.
16. If any provision of these Prize Draw Terms and Conditions is found to be invalid by any court having competent jurisdiction, the invalidity of that provision will not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of these Prize Draw Terms and Conditions, which shall remain in full force and effect.
17. These Prize Draw Terms and Conditions and any dispute or claim (including any non-contractual disputes or claims) arising out of or in connection with them will be governed by and construed in accordance with English law and all Entrants submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts in relation to any disputes or claims arising out of, or in connection with, these Prize Draw Terms and Conditions or the Prize Draw.
